

Wall Mounting with Impaling Clips (IMP-4)



INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

This installation technique uses angled Impaling Clips (IMP-4) to mount our acoustical wall panels.


1. Determine the number of IMP-4 Impaling Clips to be used per panel (see guide on the left). Horizontal panels greater than 4' wide and less than 8 SF use 3 clips.

Panel Size	# of IMP-4 Clips
less than 8 sf	2
greater than 8 sf	4
greater than 16 sf	6
greater than 32 sf	8


- 2. Lay out panel location on the wall.
- 3. Fasten IMP-4 Impaling Clips to the wall 48" O.C. with the points facing up. **Note:** If panel dimension is less than 48", space clips evenly.
- 4. Attach panels by pressing down toward the wall so points imbed firmly in the back of the panel.
- 5. This installation technique will leave a 5/8" reveal between the ceiling and the top of the panel.

Note: Due to variations in fiberglass thickness and wall inconsistencies, some shimming may be required to align the panel edges.
